Matthew 13:44-45 The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. Again the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, and upon finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it.

From Mary's Red Notebook (On Forgiveness) – Found April 24, 2007

- Forgiveness means letting go of the past.
- Forgiving is not forgetting. It is letting go of the hurt.
- It takes a strong person to say sorry, and an even stronger person to forgive.
- People are lonely because they build walls instead of bridges.
- To forgive is the highest, most beautiful form of love. In return, you will receive untold peace and happiness.
- The weak can never forgive. Forgiveness is the attribute of the strong.
- The stupid neither forgive nor forget; the naive forgive and forget; the wise forgive but do not forget.
- When a deep injury is done us, we never recover until we forgive.
- Forgiveness is the oil of relationships.
- Forgiveness does not change the past, but it does enlarge the future.
